Discussion Director	Creates 5 or less simple questions and answers that are based on Knowledge and Comprehension and are poorly edited, showing little to no thought or proof	Creates 5 or less questions that are sometimes thought provoking and are based on Analysis, Application, Knowledge and Comprehension. Answers are complete, but do not show proof	Creates more than 5 usually thought provoking questions, that are focused on Synthesis, Analysis, Application, Knowledge and Comprehension. Answers are thoughtful and show proof
Cool Connector	Includes 1 paragraph (with intro, conc) that show 1-2 simple connections (self, texts or world), and some simple editing skills shown	Includes a rough, edited and good copy of their 1 connection proper paragraph with intro, conc etc. (self, texts or world). Some mechanics used correctly	Includes a rough, edited and good copy of their 1 somewhat detailed, descriptive paragraph with intro, conc etc. (self, texts or world). Many mechanics used correctly
Word Wizard	Describes 3 or less sparkling words in 4 categories (definition, simple sentences). No mechanics used correctly	Describes 3 or less sparkling words in 4 categories (definition, compound sentences etc). Few mechanics used correctly	Describes more than 3 sparkling words in 4 categories (definition, complex sentences etc). Many mechanics or figurative language used effectively
New Narrator	Summarizes some of the main details of their story in another character's point of view in a single paragraph (leads to edit intro, conc, etc.)	Summarizes the main details of their story in another character's point of view in a somewhat detailed paragraph (leads to edit intro, conc, etc.) Few mechanics used correctly	Summarizes the main details of their story in another character's point of view in a detailed paragraph (rough, edited and good copies with intro, conc given). Many mechanics or figurative language used effectively
Pensive Predictor	Predicts some details of the sequel of their story in simple guesses having little proof.	Predicts the main details of their story using few inferences and proofs (quotes). Shows some need for editing	Predicts the main details of the sequel of their story in insightful inferences using some proofs (quotes, page numbers)
